

WHAT TO BRING CHECKLIST

Students and adults are responsible for bringing personal items and clothing that are appropriate for the season. We want your stay at Eagle Bluff ELC to be pleasant and enjoyable. Reminder: Eagle Bluff ELC is not responsible for personal property that is lost, stolen or damaged during your visit. Please have students label luggage and personal items with their name and school's name.

When packing, students and adults should put important outdoor wear such as rain gear, boots, hats and coats in a place that will be easily accessible upon arrival. Groups may not be able to check into their rooms immediately. Quick access to outdoor necessities will be important.

Please note that there will be a postage fee for any items left at Eagle Bluff that need to be mailed back to the school or individual. The fee will equal the cost of the postage necessary to mail the item(s).

Personal Gear:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -outdoor shoes, <i>(can get wet or muddy)</i> -inside shoes -rain gear, waterproof -socks, several pairs -changes of underclothing -sweater/fleece/sweatshirt -changes of clothing, including short and long sleeved shirts, short and long pants -sleeping bag or sheets & blankets -pillow -towel and washcloth -soap -shampoo -toothbrush -toothpaste -pajamas and slippers -medications -water bottle -<i>if canoeing</i>, shoes that do not fall off and can get wet/muddy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -winter hat <i>(no ear bands or ear muffs)</i> -mittens, 2 pair <i>(no gloves if possible)</i> -warm winter coat <i>(must zip)</i> -snow pants or snowmobile suit -snow boots, insulated -scarf or neck gaiter -long underwear, 2 pair -layers for upper and lower body -extra socks, NOT cotton <i>(wool or synthetic)</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -camera and extra film -sunglasses -insect repellent <i>(deet free please)</i> -gift shop money -watch -backpack -brimmed hat -writing utensils -battery-operated alarm clock -rubber boots, <i>if weather dictates</i>

Group Equipment *(brought by the organization):*

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -first aid kit -extra vehicle -cell phone -movie/ videos (optional) -Journals (optional) -games/ play equipment (optional) -group snacks and beverages (optional)

Do NOT Bring:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -electrical appliances -hair dryers or curling irons -hand held video games, iPods, CD players, etc. <i>(Eagle Bluff does not allow these in classes, we ask that you leave them at home.)</i> -food, gum, candy, or beverages -nail polish -tobacco, alcohol, drugs -student cell phones <i>(adults who bring cell phones are asked to limit calls to the chaperone lounge, personal room, and upper parking lot.)</i> -flip flops
